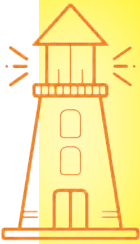

### Stay CONNECTED through Devotion -

**We Have This Confidence, The  
Word of God**

*Psalm 119:105 says, "Your Word is  
a lamp to my feet and a light to my  
path."*

Beautiful verse, but can we really trust  
the Bible to direct our every step in  
life? Let's explore that question.

Every religion has it's holy book but  
the difference with the Bible from  
every other book is the same thing  
the separates Christianity from  
every other world religion...Jesus'  
resurrection. This devotion isn't  
about the resurrection or proofs for  
the resurrection so for our purpose  
here we will jump to the belief in the  
resurrection as reliable. Once that is  
determined everything Jesus said is  
reliable because of the resurrection  
we have proof that God approved of

Jesus' message and all that Jesus  
claimed and represented.

So what did Jesus say about the Old  
Testament? In Matthew 5:18 Jesus  
said that every letter and every part  
of a letter would come to pass in  
regards to Old Testament Scripture.  
The fact that everything in it will be  
fulfilled is proof that it is relevant and  
reliable for us to use as a guide until  
it is all fulfilled. So, that covers the  
Old Testament, what about the New  
Testament?

Since Jesus' message is approved by  
God the stories of Jesus are relevant  
and reliable for us to learn from. The  
story of Jesus' life is covered in the 4  
gospels. 3 of the gospels were written  
by one of Jesus' disciples. The other,  
Luke, was written by an associate of  
Paul. In those gospels we see Jesus  
investing in his disciples, especially  
Peter. In Matthew 16:18 we see Jesus

giving Peter the authority of the church here on earth. The book of Acts tells us how Peter began the work of birthing the Church. We also see how Peter interacts with James, Jesus' brother, John and with Paul. Peter later writes about Paul in 2 Peter 3:16 where Peter compares Paul's writings to Scripture.

Another of Jesus' disciples, the one called Beloved, was John. John wrote one of the four gospels, a few letters and the prophetic book of Revelation. There is one other book included in the New Testament, Hebrews, the author of which is not known but the book was accepted by the early church as Scripture and its teaching is in alignment with books written by Peter, John, Paul and the other authors of the Gospels.

So, can the Bible show you the way you can live your life? Absolutely!
