One of my earliest recollections of Christmas was learning the song "This Little Light of Mine" along with hand gestures of holding up one finger (the candle) and the other hand would be in the form of a spider (the bushel)!. You would put the bushel over the candle to keep the light from shining! The last verse of this little tune was "keep it under a bushel NO. Let it shine until Jesus Comes!" It was reminding us of the brightest star over Bethlehem that guided Wise Men from afar who came to find the newborn Christ Child laying in a manger. Shepherds from the fields were frightened by the light of the Angels bringing the news of the newborn King!

At Christmas, there were lights everywhere to behold the birth of Baby Jesus! We had sparkling lights on our Christmas tree, bright lights decorating the outside of our house and a calming candlelight service at our church every Christmas Eve.
