**CONNECT this Sunday,  
Jan. 3rd through Worship  
“Don’t Let Your Perspective  
Grow Cold” | Peter 1:3-9**

As we enter into the coldest month of the year here in MN we can easily become cold about life as well. Cold physically, emotionally, mentally and spiritually and we can easily lose perspective of the things that should warm our hearts everyday. How can we make sure we don’t lose the warm perspective we had coming out of Christmas and what is it that we should be doing to maintain a perspective that keeps us fired up for following Jesus and walking in His ways?

**Stay CONNECTED through Devotional Prayer:  
“2021 ... Stay Focused”** by Pastor Mark Holmen

In one word how would you describe 2020? In one word, what is your desire for 2021?

Today, we begin a new sermon series that will take us through I Peter which is a letter written to God’s people that were dispersed across many regions with different rulers and regimes yet Peter’s letter would apply to each of them. And the primary theme of his letter was simply “live in obedience to Christ and His ways no matter where you are.” Peter knew his readers were in different regions facing different challenges that they would have to contend with yet that wasn’t his focus or concern. Peter will acknowledge these realities through the letter but he keeps calling everyone back to that same central theme “live in obedience to Christ and His ways no matter where you are.”

Did you know that The Log Church has people watching our live stream and recorded services from many different States and

occasionally another country or two as well? We actually have twice as many people watching our services on-line than the number who attend, in-person, each week. All praise to God! Yet, just because that is the case, this new reality doesn’t change the messages we are giving because they apply to all people, everywhere. So no matter where you are, please take some time to slowly read through I Peter 1:3-9 and identify the things God, through Peter, is wanting us to focus on no matter where we live and no matter who ends up in the White House. Yes, that’s right, God is reminding us through Peter’s letter that we are all called to keep the same focus no matter who ends up in the White House. And what is that focus supposed to be? Read through, and then rewrite I Peter 1:3-9 in your own words and in “letter” form as if you were writing it in a card to someone you know. In doing this, God will remind you of the things we should be remembering and focusing on as we move into 2021.
