We will be holding an ONLINE AUCTION! We are getting creative and hope to offer some fun items and services for people to bid on.

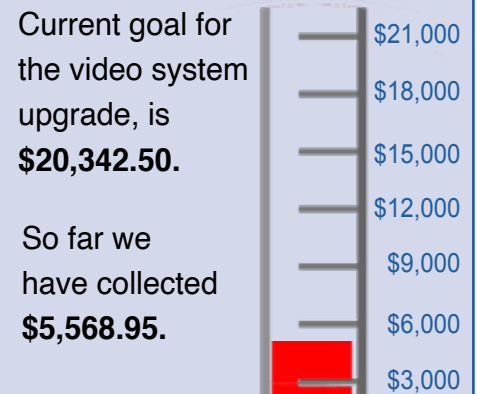

THIS WEEK'S DEVOTIONAL

Pastor Mark just wrapped up a series called Don't Grow Cold and it was very powerful, but do you know what is worst than being cold? Being lukewarm! When John wrote the book of Revelation he addresses 7 churches. One of those churches is the church in Laodicea. To that church he writes in Revelation 3:16 "So, because you are lukewarm—neither hot nor cold—I am about to spit you out of my mouth."

Think about that metaphor. When you have a drink you either like it hot or cold. When you drink coffee or hot chocolate and you go to take a sip and it has cooled off and has become lukewarm, what is your reaction? Or it's a hot day, boy could we use one of those right about now, and you go to take a drink of ice cold water but it isn't cold...it's lukewarm...what do you do?

John uses this example with the Laodicean's in order to help them understand how their lives can be a blessing or a curse to others. If they live a lukewarm Christian life they are distasteful to those around them that don't know the Lord. It is better to be a hot or cold drink, one that is refreshing or calming.

As we reflect on this passage ask yourself how are you being a comforting person, a hot drink, to others? How are you being a refreshing person, a cold drink, to others?
