







“Is Your Glass Full or is your Glass Empty ... Your Choice!”

There are a lot of conversations and scriptures to be found about our making judgments towards other people. Yet there are seldom any conversations when we indulge in self condemnation. Perhaps we don't share such negative thoughts with too many. And if we do share with others, we may be secretly hoping for some sympathy or adulation.

The Bible does provide us with God's perspective on judging ourselves. God made us and He loves us just as we are! (Isaiah 43:1. "I have called you by name; you are mine.") Stop judging and evaluating yourself, IT IS NOT YOUR ROLE because that belongs to God. Stop comparing yourself to other people or behaviors. Don't look for self affirmation in the wrong places.

(Romans 12:2 "Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, be a new person with freshness in all you do and think.") The only source of real affirmation is God's unconditional love!

What happens in your head will find it's way out and into your life. Both positive or negative thoughts can become self-fulfilling prophecies. Self condemnation is a fertile place for the Evil One to foster self doubt, warped visions and despondency. Self condemnation is the devil's empty glass.

God's positive and loving words placed firmly into your mind will determine what comes out of your heart. Positive thinking is God's glass full!

Romans 15:13. May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope."
