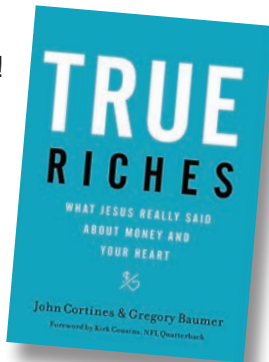

Each camp will be a fun-filled afternoon full of games, activities, songs, snacks, praise and worship centered around Christ!

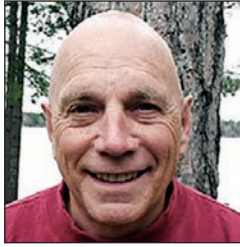

Romans 8:12-17
