SERVING OPPORTUNITIES

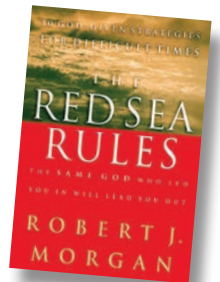
We are looking for some people

Stay CONNECTED through Devotional Prayer

“We are not all alike ... or are we?” *Submitted by Sarah Dawdy*

As a young girl, I was taught in Sunday School the song “Jesus loves the little children, all the children of the world! Red and yellow, black and white, they are precious in His sight. Jesus loves the children of the world!” Seventy years later, that song is more powerful now than ever before. I find great comfort in the realization that it was by God’s design that our world is full of color at every level of His great creation. In God’s vision of His children of differing colors, he does not see us through our outward appearance but rather He goes inward to our spirit and character.

(1 Samuel 16:7)

Color though has become a defining negative issue in today’s fallen world. Ironically much of this “negative surface only narrative” appears to surround us from a variety of secular platforms.

Proverbs 13:20 reminds us that “Whoever walks with the wise becomes wise, but the companion of fools will suffer harm.” Listening to the wisdom of those you know, and trust is especially important but there are those that will try to make you into who they think you should be instead of who God made you to be.

Each of us is a genetically unique design created by God with different physical traits of hair color, eye color, short or tall stature and skin color, all of which makes us different.
