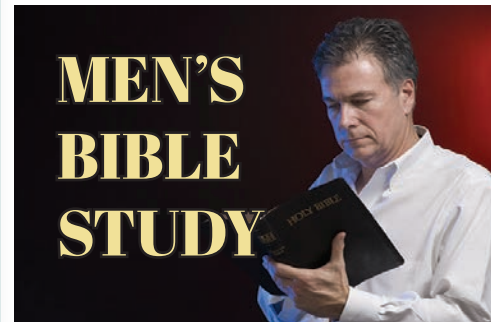

"You Are Indispensable" by Ted Schroder, *VIRTUE ONLINE*

"Now you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it."

The New Testament describes the local church through the metaphor of the body of Christ. It is a striking image. It rests on the idea of the body as the essential expression of the whole person of the crucified and risen Christ. Jesus used this image at the Last Supper when he broke bread and said, "This is my body broken for you." His body was literally to be given in sacrifice for us. "The body is a unit, though it is made up of many parts; and though all its parts are many, they form one body."

We are one in the body of Christ, but there are also many parts of that body. Paul emphasizes the indispensability of each part. We each belong to the

body. "There are many parts, but one body." We may have differing gifts, differing personalities, differing functions, but we are all indispensable to the whole. No part can say to the other, "I don't need you!" Each part should have equal concern for each other. "If one part suffers, every part suffers with it; if one part is honored, every part rejoices with it."

Everyone matters in the body of Christ. Don't think that you are not needed or essential to the working of the whole body of Christ.

The church is not other people. The church is not the preacher, the pastor, the priest, the bishop or the clergy. The church is not a committee or a program. The church is people. The church is the Body of Christ. The church is you!
