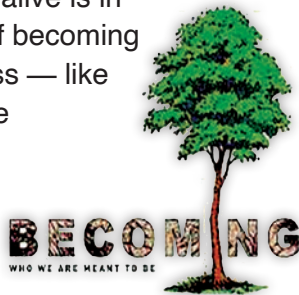


CONNECT WITH US Sunday, Oct. 17th through Worship
