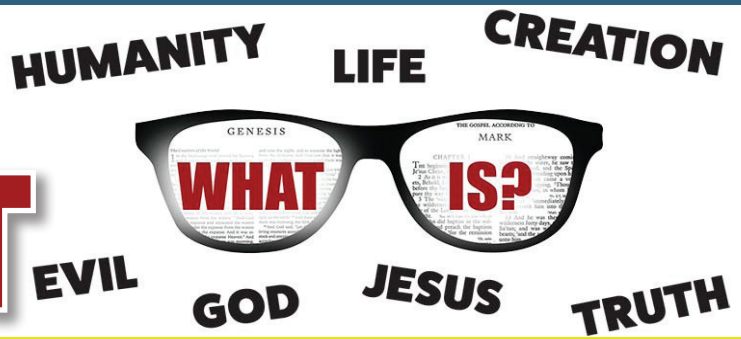

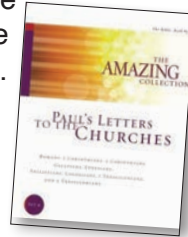
NEW SERMON SERIES THIS SUNDAY JAN. 9th

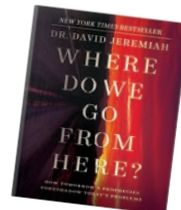

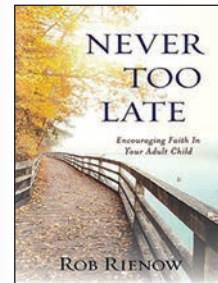
MEN'S TUESDAY MORNING GROUP

"PARENTS OF PRODIGALS" SUPPORT GROUP



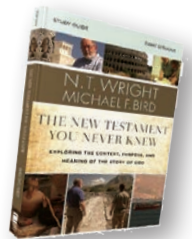
If your child is among those who are wayward, you are not alone. You know the discouragement, guilt and sleepless nights that come when one of your children or grandchildren is far from God and the family.
