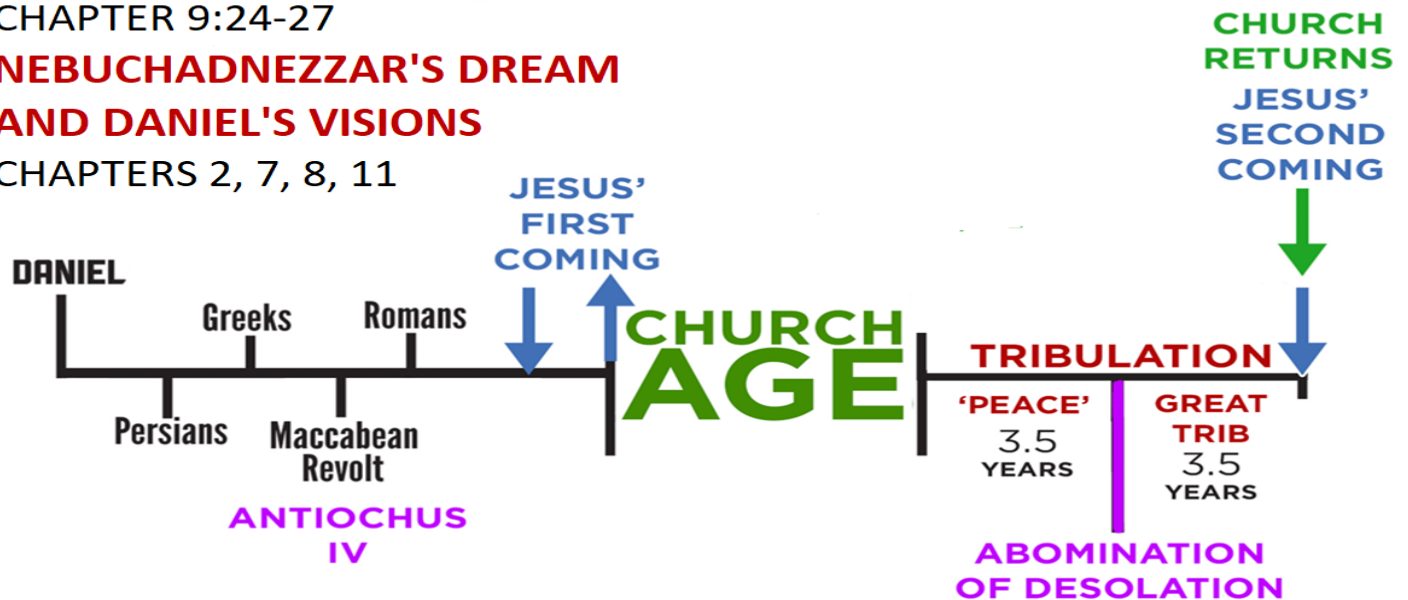

- The Jewish Levitical Feasts are seen as types of Jesus Christ. (Colossians 2:17).
- The religious leaders of Israel rejected the Messiah at his 1<sup>st</sup> coming, evidenced in each of the (4) spring feasts.
- After a gap in time (between the spring and fall feasts), the nation of Israel will receive Jesus Christ and their spiritual and national restoration at his 2<sup>nd</sup> coming, with the fall feasts.
