

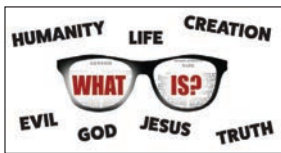

DEVOTION - submitted by Pastor Mike Neumann

Deuteronomy 30:15-20

This passage is one of Moses' final addresses to Israel. He is giving Israel one of two paths to choose: obey God and experience life (in all senses of the word) or disobey and choose death (in all senses of the word). The sad part comes later. Moses knows they will disobey and predicts the exile into Babylon.

Here's the thing: when we make choices, we are saying yes to one thing and no to another. Israel was given the choice to say yes to the fullness of life by living according to God's way of life. We see the same dilemma today. Concerning the issue of sex and sexuality, we can choose to live

according to God's precepts or we can choose life according to ours. It's not a thing of dos and don'ts, but about what brings the fullness of life. It's not homosexual verses heterosexual. There's plenty of brokenness in heterosexuality too. It's about being holy, that is, set apart for a divine purpose.

Whether you're making choices regarding sex, money, truth, or whatever it may be, we are called to be set apart. Why? We are called to choose a better standard of life. By who's standard is this held up to? The standard is by the Creator of the heavens and earth who is personal enough to know us by name. As God said in Leviticus, "Be holy, for I am holy."
