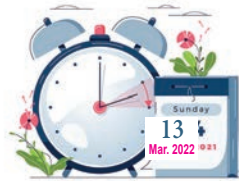
BIBLE PROPHECY: Past, Present & Future

DEVOTION - How Will You Pack Your Suitcase?

Following the events in Ukraine these past two weeks has been difficult and brutal. It has been like watching a war video game or the worst ever war film, but this war is in real time. One peculiar observation in watching over two million flee their country for survival was that most of the people were carrying a single suitcase, The logic is tragically simple, their homes and neighborhoods are being obliterated before their very eyes. How long will they be in exile, how many will have nothing left when and if they return to their homeland, and how does one decide in a few precious moments what you would pack into a single suitcase as you flee for your life. Reality landed in the pit of my stomach. As I looked around my small world, what would I choose to put in my suitcase? What is irreplaceable, what will I need to survive, and how do I prioritize essential or non-essential? I closed my eyes and asked my Sweet Jesus, what would my Savior have me put in my suitcase? His response was loving and profound. He gently reminded me that He has

many followers in this war ravaged country, and do not forget that He is control. and His answer to my question is found in His Scriptures! He explained that I will find multiple directions for paths to follow He will fill me with the Fruits of the Spirit: love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. He will provide me with His light to follow Him and I will also be a light for others to follow. He will keep my lamp burning with the Holy Spirit within me. He will never leave me or forsake me. Because He is my Lord and Savior as He is for millions in Ukraine, He will be my Bread of Life, and I shall not hunger nor ever thirst He will be my protector and comforter in times of need. Even if we walk through the shadow of death, I will not fear evil for His rod and staff will comfort me. My faith along with the Holy Bible will be the most important items in my suitcase. He will provide everything I need to survive. He will take me and all God's children, no matter the circumstances, away to Heaven with Him! And the good news is it all fits in my suitcase!
