DEVOTION - Be On Guard

2 Timothy 1:14 "Guard the good deposit that was entrusted to you—guard it with the help of the Holy Spirit who lives in us."

Are you on guard? Are you alert?
Are you watchful?

In today's key verse, Timothy reminds us to be on guard. Like a guard standing at their post, we must be actively alert, awake, and aware. And we are reminded to guard the truth.

Believers have been entrusted with a treasure of truth. This truth is precious, it is unchanging, and it is given to us as sound doctrine. We must be on guard to keep this truth protected like a prized possession. And we must guard truth, so that the lies do not try to steal it.

Like a thief in the night, the lies that surround us try to refute, confuse, and deny truth. These lies are sneaky. They are disguised like a wolf in sheep's skin. And sometimes they are barely

noticeable. They are alluring and deceptive. They are muddled just enough that - we don't even notice that truth has become compromised.

Yet, believers are called to be on guard.

But we don't have to be on guard by ourselves. Timothy also reminds us to seek the help of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit equips us to be on guard with the sword of the Spirit. The sword of the Spirit is the very truth itself. And this truth is living, active, and sharper than any double edged sword!

You see, the Holy Spirit helps us, equips us, arms us, and empowers us when the lies try to dispute truth or oppose it. And this power is available in us.

Dear friends, may we stand firm at our post - to **guard** the truth. And may we be armored with the Holy Spirit to guard this precious treasure that has been given to us in Christ Jesus.
