## DEVOTION - The Holy Spirit is So Relational

I grew up in the church not hearing much about the Holy Spirit, but there came a day as a young adult when I felt the Lord calling me to a deeper place with Him, and a hunger to know the Holy Spirit in an experiential way consumed me.

In my faith journey to know the Holy Spirit and understand what it means to walk in step with Him (Gal.5:25), and what it looks like to lean on Him as my Teacher (John 14:26) and as my Helper, Comforter, Counselor, Advocate, Intercessor, and Strengthener, I found what Jesus said in John 14:16 to be so helpful. "I will pray to the Father, and He will give you ANOTHER Helper, so that He may be with you forever." ANOTHER ... another helper like JESUS!

So when I study the Gospels and see how Jesus interacted with His disciples ... loved them, taught them, counseled them, encouraged them, led them, equipped them, I know exactly how

the Holy Spirit wants to interact with me. And I have found that to be very true.

This week as I was working on my Priscilla Shirer, Elijah study, she encouraged us to craft a prayer for anything we've been talking to the Lord about. For me, crafting a prayer is asking the Lord for HIS heart on the matter so that our prayer is lined up with HIS heart and truth. So I asked the Holy Spirit last evening to show me scripture passages that would reveal God's heart to me about an issue. In the quietness of my heart, in HIS still, small voice (John 10:27), I heard Him speak some scripture references. Not knowing what the verses would say, I looked them up ... and amazingly, they perfectly spoke to me and revealed God's heart.

I LOVE how relational the Holy Spirit is with us. It makes this faith journey with HIM full, alive, and glorious!
