DEVOTION - Get Rid of Your “Should”

“There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.”

Should is a funny word, and not in the fun sense. ‘Should’ leads to shame and both have no place in a child of God. How many of us have sat feeling guilty about not reading our Bible often enough, not praying enough? Don’t get me wrong, spiritual discipline is amazing and a sure way to deepen relationship with God. A relationship does not thrive if there is no time spent together. I will say that the “should shame” makes me even less likely to achieve spiritual discipline, and instead pushes me away from what I have often sensed as disappointment from God that I

didn’t do what I “should” to spend time with Him. That is a shame spiral that so many of us experience and does not reflect the Heart of God that loves us completely.

I’ll tell you what DOES motivate me to spend more time in the Word: remembering the grace of God. Remembering that He meets us where we are. Busy moms? This one is for you: God went to the women: at the well drawing water; Martha cooking. There is no condemnation if you don’t get the quiet time in the chaos of life. Jesus comes to you.

So open up your Bible app on your phone and listen while you cook or clean. Pray in the car. Don’t “should” yourself away from Jesus.
