

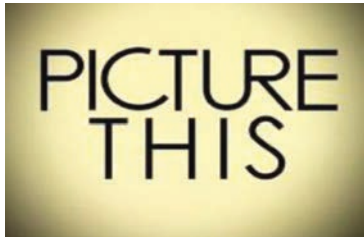

Psalm 40:5, Proverbs 3:1-13
