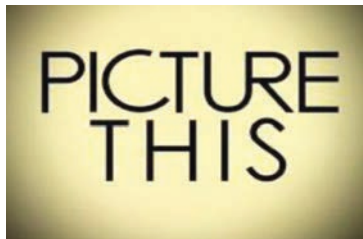

Sunday, July 24th**

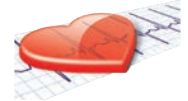
They will be leading both morning services. This band is led by Dan & Sandy Adler.

HEART HEALTH TIP

Identifying Stroke Symptoms

F.A.S.T. Warning Signs



Use the letters in FAST to spot a stroke

- **F = Face Drooping** – Does one side of the face droop or is it numb? Ask the person to smile. Is the person's smile uneven?
- **A = Arm Weakness** – Is one arm weak or numb? Ask the person to raise both arms. Does one arm drift downward?
- **S = Speech Difficulty** – Is speech slurred?
- **T = Time** to call 911

Other Stroke Symptoms

Watch for Sudden:

- **Numbness or Weakness** of face, arm, or leg, especially on one side of the body
- **Confusion** – trouble speaking or understanding speech
- **Trouble Seeing** in one or both eyes
- **Trouble Walking**, dizziness, loss of balance or coordination
- **Severe Headache** with no known cause

DEVOTION - "Who do the people say I am?"

From Mathew and Mark: Jesus asks his disciples "Who do the people say I am?" Their response: John the Baptist, Elijah, Jeremiah, one of the prophets. Then He asks: "Who do you say I am?" Simon replied: "You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God." Jesus answered: "Blessed are you, Simon."

How do you respond to Jesus's question, "Who do you say I am?"

For contemplation, author James Martin suggests asking this question to Jesus: "Jesus, who do You say I am?" What do you think would be Jesus' response, who would He say you are? At times when he looks at my heart He might reply in ways I wouldn't find pleasing. Other times I hope he would see the motives behind my words and actions and

respond with an affirmation.

Perhaps when I look upon someone else either with favor or scorn, I need then ask the question in yet another way: "Jesus, who do you say she or he is?" Asking the question in that way should remind me how Jesus holds others. Even those who I dislike or those whom I admire. The verse who is my neighbor comes to mind, as does the one about loving my enemy.

Martin, as he leads his readers through the verses from Mathew, shares his thoughts about how Jesus would respond if asked "My Lord who do You say I am?" Martin suggests that Jesus may respond so simply: "You ask whom I say you are? You are my child, and I love you."
