# **DEVOTION - ACTS: It's Not Just A Sermon Series-Part 1!**

We are in the middle of a wonderful sermon series on Acts! But ACTS is also an easy-to-remember acronym for an effective prayer model: A: Adoration; C: Confession; T: Thanksgiving; S: Supplication. We'll look first at adoration.

Job 38 is filled with worshipworthy accomplishments from God as he reminded Job of His power: God laid the foundations of the earth, set the boundaries for the seas, holds storehouses of snow and hail, and numbered the clouds! Psalm 147: 4 says "He counts the number of the stars; He calls them all by name." Luke 12:7 says "And even the very hairs of your head are all numbered." In the Old Testament, God led the people through a pillar of cloud by day and a pillar of fire by night, but now we have the Holy Spirit to guide us. We have the supreme redemptive sacrifice that Christ made on the cross. And our unimaginable reward is heaven. 1 Corinthians 2: 9 says "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard. Nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him." These things, and countless more, can be a focus in the adoration phase of our prayers! Jesus said if we don't worship, "...the very rocks would cry out." Luke 19:40
