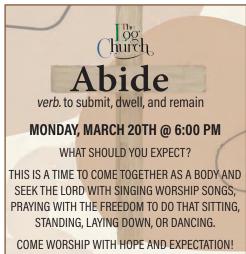

### **DEVOTION - ACTS: It's Not Just A Sermon Series-Part 2!**

We are in the middle of a wonderful sermon series on Acts! But ACTS is also an easy-to-remember acronym for an effective prayer model: A: Adoration; C: Confession; T: Thanksgiving; S: Supplication. Today we'll look at confession.

We are all fallen creatures buried in sin, shame, and guilt. We can ask God to search us and show us where we have fallen short. Confession involves admitting our wrongs. Repentance involves a desire to change course. In repentance, we not only acknowledge our sin but take steps to overcome and forsake it. Daily, we need to deal with our sin and put it away so that we can move forward unhindered by it.

Not only are we to confess our sins to God, we need to confess to others we've wronged and ask for forgiveness. It's important to seek the forgiveness of those we've hurt, even if it is hard to do. Jesus said in Matthew 5: 23-24 "if your brother or sister has something against you ... First go and be reconciled to them".

As we have studied the Old Testament in Bible Study Fellowship this year, we have seen a recurring theme of God's people turning the wrong way, worshipping idols and rejecting God. Yet God's love is so strong that He always renews His blessings and love for His people if we humble ourselves and pray! What a marvelous gift we have in a heavenly Father who forgives us when we confess and repent!
