As we prepare for Easter, we would love to decorate with Easter Lilies!

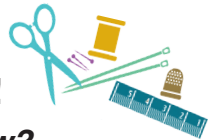
This Sunday there will be a sign-up sheet in the Gathering Place where you can place an order. Cost is \$25.00 ea.

## DEVOTION - ACTS: It's Not Just A Sermon Series-Part 3!

We are in the middle of a wonderful sermon series on Acts! But ACTS is also an easy-to-remember acronym for an effective prayer model:

**A:** Adoration; **C:** Confession;  
**T:** Thanksgiving; **S:** Supplication.

1 Thessalonians 5:18 says "in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you." In EVERYTHING!
