Crosslake Community Charter School and the American Red Cross are hosting an upcoming blood drive. Please join our lifesaving mission and schedule an appointment today!



DEVOTION - What is Truth?

John 14:6, John 18:33-38

Have you heard the term "Orwellian" before? It comes from George Orwell's book 1984. It describes a type of double speech where terms are redefined to achieve a particular purpose. Examples from the book include the propaganda department being called, "Ministry of Truth" and interrogation and torture of descendants being called, "Ministry of Love."

You don't need to go far to see that happening today. Orwellian does not mean authoritarian. It can happen in free, democratic countries too. Tell me, what does racism mean? How about what a woman is? These terms are muddied and confusing because they have been redefined to fit a particular narrative.

In the passages above Jesus emphasizes He is truth. Not too

far into the future He, the living Truth, stands before Pilate who asks, "What is truth?" Ultimately we know what is truth because of God. He is truth. We know this from the above passage and from other ones like John 15:26, which talks about the Holy Spirit, or Hebrews

6:18, which says God cannot lie.

When we search for what is true, we need to line up with God. He revealed Himself through the Bible, His special revelation. Though the Bible may not outline what a woman is like a biology textbook, we can see what a woman is because of how God, the Creator, designed them to be. We can see what racism is because of how God has created humans and His call to love others.

We need to be people of truth. If not, we misrepresent God. I'm not saying this will be easy, but if God is for us, who can be against us?

One in a series of books focused on the holocaust by Heather Morris, **The Tattooist of Auschwitz** tells the story of a Jewish man who is tasked with permanetly marking his fellow prisioners. He uses his position to try to keep them alive. One day he meets a trembling young woman waiting in line to have the number 34902 tattooed onto her arm. At that moment he vows to somehow survive the camp and marry her. Check this and several other books in the series out at The Log Church Library.
