One in a series of books focused on the holocaust by Heather Morris, **The Tattooist of Auschwitz** tells the story of a Jewish man who is tasked with permanently marking his fellow prisoners. He uses his position to try to keep them alive. One day he meets a trembling young woman waiting in line to have the number 34902 tattooed onto her arm. DEVOTION - The Walking Dead *submitted by Pastor Mike Neumann*

Ephesians 2:1-10

In the passage of Ephesians 2, Paul contrasts the Ephesus church's change from spiritual deadness to life. As a result of everyone having a sin nature, we are all born spiritually dead. We are in need of redemption and spiritual resuscitation. Enter in Jesus and His gospel message.

Until we allow Jesus to be lord and the Holy Spirit to rejuvenate us, we are the walking dead. We shamble along, dying spiritually, and physically until our bodies give out. In that time our lives strive after desires and things that end when we do. Even if we have a big impact, the question is to what end?

Now enter Jesus and His reformation of the heart. Though we may die physically, what we do here echoes into eternity. Because there is a God and there is heaven and hell, what we do has real impact, meaning, and results that can outlive us because we are focused on the eternal.

We are left at a crossroads. We can continue to live as the walking dead. Yes, even people who are at church every time the doors are open can be the walking dead. Or, we can allow the Holy Spirit to transform us by calling Jesus lord and join the walking reborn.
