


WELCOME TO THE LOG CHURCH - MAY 28TH

DEVOTION - The Fragrance of Christ

My favorite flower, for its gentle, poignant fragrance, is the Lilac. My Lilacs are just coming to full bloom this week, and I can't wait for the breeze to waft that enchanting fragrance into my home. It is something I look forward to each spring.

Because I have been fairly transient in my adult life, I have visited many, many churches - even "church shopped" a few times. The thing that attracts me to a particular church is not so much the aesthetics of the physical property, the worship music or even the teaching from the pulpit, as long as they are Biblical and centered on Jesus. It is the warmth and welcoming of the people I meet there. People I've never met before, who go out of their way to take the risk to introduce themselves to me and make me feel welcome. They might even invite

me to join them for coffee or brunch after the service. This is what we are to do, as believers, if we are to extend ourselves to the body (and even someone we don't know). Too often we allow ourselves to gather in our "holy huddle" with friends we see each week, when there are new people or visitors who don't know anyone. Meeting a new person is not the easy or comfortable thing to do, but it is what God has called us to do, in loving the brethren.

II Cor 2: 15, 16 says, "For we are the fragrance of Christ to God among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing; to the one an aroma from death to death, to the other an aroma from life to life."

Go, and be the fragrance of Christ - of life to life - to someone on Sunday morning who you don't (yet) know.
