### **DEVOTION - Strong & Courageous** submitted by Ann Anderson

I am awestruck by Joshua's role in leading the Israelites into the promised land. Our small group is studying Joshua, who was chosen by God to lead the Israelites after Moses died. "After the death of Moses, the servant of the Lord, the Lord said to Joshua son of Nan, Moses' aide: "Moses my servant is dead. Now then, you and all these people, get ready to cross the Jordan River into the land I am about to give to them – to the Israelites." (Joshua 1:1-2) What a promise. What a call from the Lord.

Joshua had the perfect preparation for leadership. He had lived with Moses and had the opportunity to learn from one of the most humble, faithful leaders. I am sure Moses had stories to share about how he was refined by the Lord after trying to duck the calling, reacting poorly in situations and having to be corrected, and learning to buffer God's anger at the Israelites for

their failings. Yet Moses knew that God was always with him and so did Joshua. Imagine being witness to how God molded Moses for His purposes. This was ideal mentorship and while God refined Moses, he also refined Joshua for His purpose.

We could benefit from asking the Lord to guide us to capable mentors who have been refined by the Lord and are humble servants with experiences from which we can learn. These mentors would be our Moses.

The Lord, when calling Joshua, promised to be with him and commanded him on four occasions to be strong and courageous. The Lord did not ask Joshua if he wanted to lead, he expected him to step into the role as he guided him. The Lord called him to be strong and courageous. Learn from your Moses so when you receive your calling to something bold, you are strong and courageous. This is how we bring glory to the Lord our God.
