DEVOTION - Transformational Love submitted by Pastor Mike Neumann

Luke 19:1-10

We all know the story of Zacchaeus. You probably sang the song as a kid or sang it to kids. Yeah, Zacchaeus was a cheat. He stole from people and supported the enemy. He gave very little reason for people to like him. In his mind it was worth it. He got rich so forget the rest of the people who hated him. This was probably exacerbated by his small stature (see small man syndrome).

Then Jesus came along. Zacchaeus was so intrigued by Him he climbed a tree to get a better look. Jesus invited him down to share a meal with him. This was a type of love that Zacchaeus was probably not used to. So what happens? Does Jesus give him a short sermon and then send him on his way, no different? Maybe He flips the table at his house? Jesus called Zacchaeus to God's way of life and Zacchaeus responded favorably.

See what happened? As Jesus showed love, Zacchaeus was changed. A lot of people outside the church will use Jesus to justify themselves by saying, "Jesus loved the sinners." They're absolutely right. What happened when Jesus encountered the sinner was that they were changed. They didn't walk away from Him being the same. Even the rich young ruler in Mark 10 was impacted. We don't know if he changed his ways, but he couldn't be the same.

Yes, Jesus loved the sinner, but He called them to a higher standard. By that way, Jesus loved them too. He called them out of sin and depravity into God's way. In that same way we ourselves and everyone else is being called to God's way. How? Through the love Jesus demonstrated. That's why He calls us to love too.
