JOY IN COMMUNITY


Philippians 1:1-11


We will be doing a scavenger hunt across Crosslake. More details to follow, but we will end up at Craft and Cones eventually so bring cash for ice cream.

DEVOTION - Freedom submitted by Pastor Mike Neumann

Galatians 5:13-14

In order to fully grasp what Paul is talking about in this passage, you will need to read the entirety of chapter 5. Remember, even though I'm highlighting this section, it's dangerous to read just a verse. The fuller context brings to life what the Scripture is trying to communicate.

Paul is advocating for freedom.
Why? Freedom is a concept
God designed. It doesn't mean
unadulterated actions. Rather,
freedom is best understood with
parameters set by the Creator. No
rational person would advocate
you can do whatever you want at
any given time. Rather, freedom
still comes with guidelines because
we live in a universe of cause and
effect. In Eden there was freedom
but with parameters to keep the

people living out God's call for them in paradise.

Read what Paul says we should do with our freedom. If you read past this verse, you come to the Fruit of the Spirit section. When we are living according to God's call, freedom plays out to be a beautiful thing. When we don't live within God's call, we get the fruits of the flesh. Look at that list and the Fruits of the Spirit and tell me which sounds better.

With our freedom in America we are called to use it to bring others to Jesus. We are called to serve others and love them as God loved us. That doesn't mean being belligerent in sharing the gospel or fighting for a political ideology. It means loving others the way Jesus showed us so they can find paradise here and in eternity.
