DEVOTION - Joy submitted by Sarah Dawdy

In the Bible, the words "joy," "rejoice," or "joyful" appear a total of 430 times, compared with "happy" or "happiness," which appear only 10 times. Joy is to be lasting, and it comes to us in many variations!

Lasting Joy: Sorrow and suffering will pass, but joy continues inspite of hardship. Eternal joy is promised to come and, when it does, it lasts. Psalm 30:5 "For his anger is but for a moment, and his favor is for a lifetime. Weeping may tarry for the night, but joy comes with the morning."

Satisfying Joy: Joy is characteristic of God's people, found in his presence. Christian joy is our relationship in Christ: who you are in Him, and what He has done for you! John 15:1 "These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full."

Ever-Present Joy: Throughout the Old and New Testaments, fullness of joy is found in the presence of the Lord.1 Chronicles 16:27 "Splendor and majesty are before him; strength and joy are in his place."

Spirit-Filled Joy: No power of positive thinking can bring lasting joy. Instead, joy is a supernatural work of the Holy Spirit within us! Galatians 5:22-23: "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law."

Deliberate Joy: We are commanded to be glad, rejoice, and shout for joy. Joy is a deliberate act of obedience in response to who Christ is and what he has done. Psalm 32:11 "Be glad in the Lord, and rejoice, O righteous, and shout for joy, all you upright in heart!" AMEN
