DEVOTION - Can Your Faith Save You? Not Actually ... submitted by Mark Moselle

I spent several years in East
Africa teaching Christian pastors
the essence of evangelism and
discipleship. One of the things we
eventually studied was faith. We
would talk about putting our faith
in Jesus in order to have eternal
life. He is the object of our faith.

In order to help them better understand this concept, I talked about growing up in Minnesota. I told them that when winter time came, one could walk on the frozen water of the lake. They were astonished. "Do you mean like Jesus did?" Well, not exactly, I would reply. The lake froze, and when the ice became thick enough, one could not only walk on it, you could even drive a car on it. They were incredulous.

I taught them that I was putting my faith in the ice to hold me up. But it wasn't the amount of faith I had - it was the object of my faith - the ice. If I had all the faith in the world, and the ice in early December was only a half inch thick, my faith was placed in something untrustworthy, and I would fall though and be soaked in the water below. But, if the ice in February was three feet thick, even with very little faith, these African pastors could slowly inch their way onto the lake to discover that it was indeed strong enough to hold them up and not fall through. It was not the amount of faith they had, it was the object of their faith. In our Christian walk, it is not our faith that saves us, but the object of our faith - Jesus.

Galatians 2:16 says, "Yet we know that a person is not justified by works of the law, but through faith in Jesus Christ, so we also have believed in Christ Jesus, in order to be justified by faith in Christ and not by works of the law . . "

So, my question for you is, "Is it your faith that will save you, or the object of your faith?"
