DEVOTION - The True Worshippers - Chapter 2

"... But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; ... God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth." - John 4:23-24 NKJV

These words to the woman at the well in Samaria are Jesus' first recorded teaching on the subject of prayer because prayer is worship. And this Scripture gives us a wonderful first glimpse into the world of prayer. The Father seeks worshippers; our worship satisfies His loving heart and is a joy to Him. He seeks true worshippers but finds few. True worship must be in spirit and truth.

... However, we are carnal, and our flesh cannot bring God the worship that He seeks. But Jesus came to give us the Holy Spirit. Let the attitude we bring to prayer be what Christ taught us; a deep confession of our inability to bring God the worship that is pleasing to Him and a childlike teachableness that waits on Him to instruct us in the simple faith that yields itself to the breathing of the Holy Spirit.

This is the new and living way Christ opened up for us (Hebrews 10:20). Having Christ the Son, and the Holy Spirit dwelling within us and revealing the Father to us makes us true spiritual worshippers of God our Father.
