### **Devotion - Burning Embers** submitted by: Mark Moselle

Fall might be the best time for campfires, as temps lower and Minnesota bugs disappear. Have you ever watched a campfire when the flames go down and the embers are glowing a beautiful, bright yellow? If you take notice, the embers that are part of the pile of the original fire continue to glow hot and bright for hours. Occasionally, one ember will roll off the pile and burn by itself. That ember, away from the rest of the glowing embers, quickly loses its heat, its glow, and will swiftly die out.

Last week, Pastor Troy taught from Philippians about the importance of

gathering together with other believers, particularly in small groups. Sometimes, we are satisfied to be alone, watch the service via Zoom and not commit to being a part of the "body", as we are exhorted to do. If this describes you, consider the lone ember on the side of the pile of glowing embers as it loses it's heat, being all alone.

Hebrews 10: 24, 25 says, "let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and do good deeds, not forsaking our own assembling together.

... encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the day approaching."


