


WELCOME TO THE LOG CHURCH - OCT. 8TH

Disciples of the early church recognized the work of the church - gathering, teaching, feeding, and serving people. The disciples assembled and said "it would not be right to neglect the ministry of the word of God in order to wait on tables. Brothers and sisters, choose seven men among you who are known to be full of the Spirit and wisdom. We will turn this responsibility over to them and will give our attention to prayers and ministry of the word." Acts 6:2-4 Our church has pastors, elders, and deacons.
