

Devotion - The Certainty of the Answer to Prayer - Lesson 5 submitted by: Karen Kettleson

"Ask, and it shall be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened."

- Matthew 7:7-8 NIV

What Jesus teaches here is that the chief thing we need to know about prayer is the assurance that we will be heard and answered. He uses words that mean almost the same thing and each time repeats the promise distinctly: "You shall receive ... you shall find ... it shall be opened unto you." And then He gives as the ground for such assurance the law of the kingdom: "For everyone who asks receives, the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened.

The first word, Ask, refers to the

gifts we pray for. But I may ask and receive the gift without the Giver. Seek is the word Christ uses to assure me that I can find Him. Knock speaks of admission to dwell with Him and in Him.

Asking and receiving the gift would thus lead to seeking and finding the Giver, and this again, leads to the knocking and opening of the door of the Father's home and love.

Receiving an answer, finding God and finding the open heart and home of God are the certain fruit of prayer. (See Psalm 63:1-8.)
