


WELCOME TO THE LOG CHURCH - NOV. 5TH

More Christians died for their faith in the 20th century than the previous 19 combined, and the 21st century is shaping up to be at least as deadly, but likely more. According to Open Doors International's latest World Watch List, 312 million Christians face "extreme" or "very high" levels of persecution. Africa:1 in 5; Asia: 2 in 5. Last year was the worst year on record for persecution, with 5,500 Christians killed for reasons related to their faith, more than 2,000 churches attacked, and over 4,500 Christians detained or imprisoned. For the most part, each year of the past decade has been worse than the previous year.
