

Devotion - The All-Coomprehensive Gift (Lesson 7)

"... If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!" - Luke 11:13 NKJV

In the sermon on the mount in Matthew, Jesus had already said, "How Much More?" Here in Luke, where He repeats the question, there is a difference. Instead of speaking of giving good gifts, He says, "How much more shall the Heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him?" He is teaching that the chief and the best of these gifts is the Holy Spirit, and that in this gift, all others are comprised. The Holy Spirit is the Father's first gift and the one He delights most to give. The Holy Spirit is the gift we ought to seek first.

Jesus spoke of the Holy Spirit as "The promise of the Father" (Luke 24:49), the promise in which God's Fatherhood revealed itself. It is impossible to conceive of God bestowing any higher gift on His children on earth than His own Spirit.

This truth naturally suggests the thought that this first and chief gift of God must be the first and chief object of all prayer. For every need of the spiritual life, this is the one thing needful — the Holy Spirit.
