

#### **Devotion - The Boldness of God's Friends (Lesson 8)**

Then, teaching them more about prayer, (Jesus) used this story: "Suppose you went to a friend's house at midnight, wanting to borrow three loaves of bread. You say to him, 'A friend of mine has just arrived for a visit, and I have nothing for him to eat.' And suppose he calls out from his bedroom, 'Don't bother me. The door is locked for the night, and my family and I are all in bed. I can't help you.' But I tell you this—though he won't do it for friendship's sake, if you keep knocking long enough, he will get up and give you whatever you need because of your shameless persistence." Luke 11 5-8 NLT

The disciples asked Jesus to teach them to pray (Luke 11:1). In answering, He gave them, for a second time, what we call the Lord's Prayer, this time teaching them how they ought to pray (Luke 11:9-13), and repeating what He formerly said of the certainty of an answer to their prayers. He then adds the parable of the friend at midnight to teach them this threefold lesson:

First: God does not want us to pray only for ourselves. Second: We are to pray for perishing unbelievers around us. Third: In praying for salvation for others, great boldness and even annoving persistence are needed and are pleasing to God.
