Then (Jesus) said to His disciples, "The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest." — Matthew 9:37-38 NKJV

Prayer truly is the power on which the in gathering of the harvest and the coming of God's Kingdom depend. It was when *"Jesus saw the multitude, and was moved with compassion on them, because they were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd"* (verse 36), that He called on the disciples to pray for laborers to be sent among them.
