Only a week had passed since Jesus's triumphant entrance into Jerusalem—but on the morning Jesus was crucified and laid in the borrowed tomb, there were no cheering crowds, no waving branches. Just a few silent women setting out in the gray dawn to perform the last sad rites at the tomb. The day that changed human history was not a public occasion but a private one. The day when eternal life was secured through the resurrection of Jesus Christ began not with celebration but with tears.

Mary Magdalene could not believe what her eyes were telling her; she thought Jesus to be a gardener at work early among the graves. 
