

#### **Devotion - "Prayer Must be Definite" Lesson 10**

... a blind man sat by the road begging. ... saying, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" ... (Jesus) asked him, saying, "What do you want Me to do for you?" ... He said, "Lord, that I may receive my sight."

-Luke 18:35-41 NKJV

The blind man had been crying out persistently, "Son of David, have mercy on me." But before Jesus restored his sight, He asked him, "What do you want Me to do for you?" Jesus wanted to hear from his own lips the distinct expression of his need and desire. Until the blind man speaks it out, he is not healed.

When we pray the Lord puts the same question to us, "What do you want me to do for you?" Our prayers also must be a distinct expression of a definite need. Jesus desires a definite request for our own sake.

Such definite prayer teaches us to know our own needs better. It demands time, thought, and self-scrutiny. It searches us and puts us to the test as to whether our desires are honest and real. It leads us to judge whether our desires are according to God's word and His will. And it examines us to know whether we really believe that we shall receive the things we ask. And then in faith, we wait for the specific answer.
