Devotion - The Resurrection *submitted by: Pastor Mike Neumann*

Philippians 2:5-11

The Jews don't see Jesus as the Messiah, but the Christians do. Why is there this discrepancy? In an interview with William Lane Craig, a Christian apologist, Ben Shapiro, a Jewish political commentator, asked him why Jesus is the Christ. Dr. Craig pointed to the resurrection as vindication from God that Jesus was who He said He was. The Jews see the resurrection as a single, corporate event in history. They see Jesus dying a criminal's death, which meant He was under God's curse. This is no Messiah.

Read the passage in Philippians listed above. Paul, a Jew and

former Pharisee, understood exactly what the resurrection meant. Jesus was the first resurrection, leading to many more and ultimately the one on the day of judgment. Jesus was to be under God's curse so we wouldn't have to be. He died a criminal, in place of a criminal (Barabbas). Why? So we don't have to.

The Jews misunderstand the why. They are right about the details, but miss the why behind it. How do we know it all played out the way it should? On the third day, a miraculous event happened where a dead Jesus breathed again and left the tomb. On that day, He was crowned as the King.
