



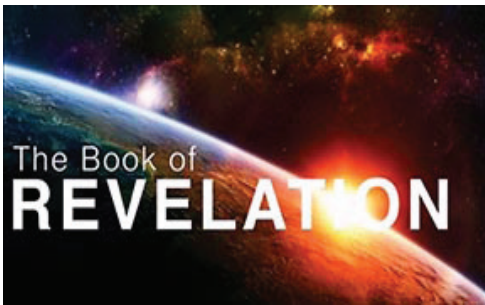

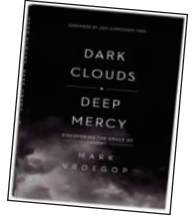

Devotion - "Have Faith in God" The Secret of Believing Prayer - Lesson 12 *submitted by: Karen Kettleson*

"Have faith in God," Jesus answered ... "if anyone says to this mountain, 'Go, throw yourself into the sea,' and does not doubt in their heart but believes ... 17: Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it ..." —Mark 11:22-24 NIV

Before Jesus gave that wonderful promise He pointed out where the faith in answer to prayer begins and always finds its strength. Before He said, have faith in the promise of an answer to prayer, He said, "Have faith in God." The power to believe a promise depends entirely on faith in the Promiser.

Have faith in the Living God -- let faith look to God and His word more than to the thing promised. The Father's love, His power, and His living presence will waken and work faith in the believer.

It is only where we live and relate with God in personal, loving intimacy, where God Himself is everything and our whole being is continually opened and exposed to His mighty influences at work in our spirit, and where His Holy Presence is revealed, that the capacity will be developed for believing the promise.

Again ... the true value depends on the one who promises. It is on my hearing God the Promiser that my faith in the promise depends.
