Devotion - Atheism is Dead Ecclesiastes 3:11

German thinker, Friedrich Nietzsche, is known for saying, "God is dead." His idea was that, because of the Enlightenment, we had no need for God. God was something that kept us bound and with the Enlightenment we could be free to make our lives as we choose. Evolutionary biologist, Richard Dawkins, would share a similar idea, denying God and saying that life is, "blind, pitiless indifference."

I am paraphrasing here, but as you read the full context of what each man said, you would walk away thinking God is archaic and unnecessary. Atheism is the logical, neutral standpoint that makes the most sense of the world. I mean, does it? To be an atheist, one would have to claim to have enough knowledge to rule out a god. To do that, one would have to be all knowing. To do that, one would have to be outside of time and space. To do that, one would have to be immortal. To do that, one would have to be God. See how that works? Atheism, at its core, is making the self God while claiming God doesn't exist.

The best one can do to be removed from God is to be agnostic, saying we can't know for sure. Even then, they must deny the overwhelming evidence of creation to accomplish that. The most logical, fact driven assessment of our existence is that there is a God who created everything with precision and care. He is intimately involved with His creation and interested in its redemption. Atheism is dead.
