

#### **Devotion - Silence in the Face of Evil** James 2:14-26

Dietrich Bonhoeffer found himself in a precarious position. It was November 6, 1932 and he was to speak to the German church at the Kaiser Wilhelm church in Berlin. He confronted the church about their apathy in the face of a rising evil and used the term "cheap grace." Cheap grace is the type of grace that gets a person into heaven but requires very little in the way of transformation and personal responsibility here on earth. It was a "Get Out of Hell Free Card."

In his book, <u>Letters to the</u>
<u>American Church</u>, Eric Metaxas
uses the life of Bonhoeffer and
the historical context he lived in
to illustrate the parallels we see
now. If you were to go through
the case Metaxas makes and look
at his evidence, I think you'll be
alarmed at just how closely related
circumstances are.

Now let me be clear: I'm not saying anyone is in danger of death camps. I'm not calling anyone evil or a threat to American life. The point of this, with the passage in James, is that to see evil and not

act in a biblical way is evil. I specify biblical to be clear our actions must line up with a biblical way of life. What Bonhoeffer found was the German church justifying inaction because they felt they were only to preach the gospel and steer clear of politics or current events. How foolish they were.

Cheap grace relegates faith to Sunday mornings and only to certain dimensions of life. True, authentic grace is lived out every day in every way. It permeates what we do and say and is influenced by the Holy Spirit, which is confirmed with the Scriptures. As we face times when evil seems to run rampant, we can't sit idly by and say it's not our fight. At the same time we need to remember with whom our allegiance truly lies first and foremost: Jesus. Start in your homes by reading God's word and being in regular prayer. Do this with your spouse, kids, roommate, whomever you live with. Attend church in person regularly. Know the biblical values so you can live them out when you work, go shopping, play on the lake, wherever you are. This is how faith and works coincide.
