Devotion - Honoring Our Parents (Part 1) submitted by: Tim & Laurie Prem

"Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. "Honor your father and mother," which is the first commandment with promise: "that it may be well with you, and you may live long on the earth." " (Ephesians 6:1-3)

There is great power in the scriptures surrounding the fact we are to honor our parents. **The relationship with our parents** is so significant that it is the first earthly relationship addressed in the commandments in Exodus 20:12, and it's the only one to come with a blessing from God.

In Ephesians 6:2, Paul emphasizes the promise of parental honor: *"that it may be well with you, and you may live long on the earth."* Earthly circumstances and personal choices have

created situations where those who dishonor their parents live long lives and those who honor their parents die young. But a promise of that magnitude from our Lord has great purpose. We surely want to live under the protection of that blessing!

Jesus set a perfect example of honoring his mother, Mary. He tasked himself with her well-being until his last hours on the cross when he asked the apostle John to take her into his care.

In addition to Jesus, two of the people I most long to see again when I reach heaven are my Christian mother and father! While our relationships weren't perfect here on earth, they will be perfected in heaven in the presence of Christ our Lord. Praise the Lord!
