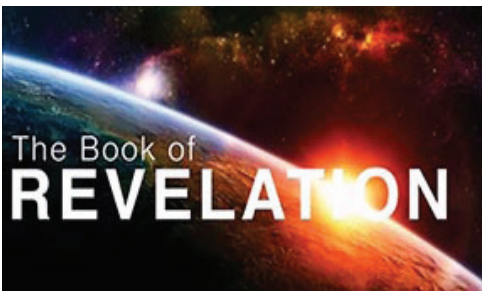

Devotion - Prayer, Love, and Forgiveness - Lesson 14

"And when you stand praying, if you hold anything against anyone, forgive them, so that your Father in heaven may forgive you your sins."
(Mark 11:25).

We have already seen how the words that preceded that promise, *"Have faith in God"* (Mark 11:22), taught us that everything in prayer depends upon our loving relationship with God. The words that follow remind us that our relationship with people must be in love and forgiveness, too. Love for God and love for our neighbor are inseparable. A prayer from a person whose heart is not right with God on the one side or right with another person on the other cannot prevail with God.

Faith and love are essential to each other. In the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5-7), Jesus taught His disciples that it is

impossible to have acceptable worship of the Father when everything is not right in your relationship with others. *"If you are offering your gift at the altar, and there remember that your brother has something against you, leave your gift before the altar, then go and first be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift to God"* (Matthew 5:23-24; 18:15).

Father, it is clear by these scriptures that whether I am the one who has offended someone, or I am the one who has been offended, I am to take the initiative in forgiveness. Help me to obey, in the Forgiving Name of Jesus. Amen
