

## **Devotion - The Power of United Prayer - Lesson 15**

"... if two of you on earth agree about anything they ask for, it will be done for them by my Father in heaven. For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them." Matthew 18:19-20 NIV.

One of the first lessons of Jesus in His school of prayer was to have a private place for intimate time alone with the Father. Now here His lesson is to pray with other believers in united prayer. The secrecy in which we meet God alone in prayer is like the root; public prayer is like a tree that grows above the ground and is seen. Both private and public prayer are needed equally for prayer's full development.
