DEVOTION - Light of the World submitted by Pastor Mike Neumann

John 3:16-21

This world is quite the place to live. It's an eclectic mix of beauty and brokenness. It mixes virtue with depravity. Charles Dickens was right when he wrote, "It was the best of times; it was the worst of times."

I think we can feel overwhelmed by the worst of times. We can feel attacked and beaten down because of what we believe. Jesus was very clear the world would hate His followers on His account. Why hate what is good? This passage in John explains it well: the darkness is loved therefore the Light is hated.

A question to ask is, "by what standard do they judge the darkness as good?" In the end, they have to have a standard of some sort to justify their position. As they develop their own standard based on their own rationale, it falls apart at a certain point. In order to justify their position, they need to steal the standard from the Light. Ironic isn't it? We walk in the light because it is the only true standard that makes sense and works. After all, the light exposes the darkness for what it truly is. The same is true with the Light of the world.
